

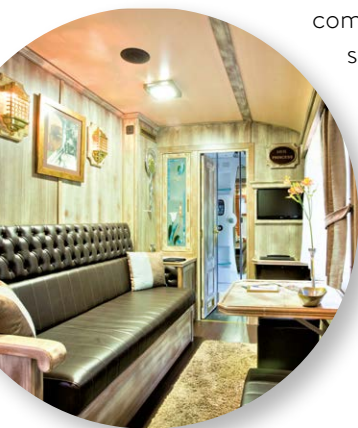


EL TRASCANTÁBRICO GRAN LUJO

El Transcantábrico began operating in 1983 in León, was renovated in the year 2000, and then completely overhauled in 2011 to become El Transcantábrico Gran Lujo, one of the most exclusive and luxurious trains in the world. Being designed for a narrow-gauge railway, it enables you to enjoy nature in all its splendour, from high mountains to the Cantabrian coast, passing through valleys and along riverbanks. An unforgettable trip full of glamour, scenery, culture, and beauty.

Accommodation

El Transcantábrico Gran Lujo is one of the most luxurious trains in the world. Its Grand Luxury suites are designed for rest and privacy. Since there are only 14 suites in the train's 7 cars, spaciousness, comfort, and exclusivity are guaranteed. Each suite can be used as a single, double, or triple room. This Grand Luxury Suite is a spacious, wood-panelled room adorned with exclusive details. It is made up of a lounge, bedroom, and private bathroom. The sleeping area features a spacious double bed (150x200 cm) or two twin beds, TV, and wardrobe, while the lounge area has a comfortable sofa, which can be turned into a bed, luggage closet, writing desk, safe, minibar, flatscreen TV, music player, adjustable air-conditioning, multimedia computer with free Internet access, and internal telephone service. All suites feature their own spacious, comfortable bathroom, with a hydromassage shower and steam sauna, hairdryer, and a varied set of welcome items and toiletries.



The Common Lounges

These are original 1923 Pullman cars, veritable railway gems, designed and decorated specifically for El Transcantábrico Gran Lujo. The common areas are where our à la carte breakfasts are served. You will enjoy savouring our prize-winning chef's best cuisine in their dining rooms, while our bar will be at your disposal 24 hours a day. In the lounges, you will find national and international newspapers, television, a selection of books and videos, board games, etc. You will be able to relax in our panoramic lounge, have an aperitif in our tearoom, or enjoy a lively evening in our club car, which features parties, live music, and performances each evening. Our crew will be at your service 24 hours a day.



Itinerary

FROM SAN SEBASTIÁN TO SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

8 days – 7 nights

Day 1: San Sebastián – Carranza

Meeting point in San Sebastian's Hotel Barceló-Costa Vasca at 1 pm. Tour of the city and lunch. Our luxury coach will then take us to Bilbao, where El Transcantábrico will be waiting for us. Welcome and settling in. Dinner on board and overnight stay in Carranza.

Day 2: Carranza – Santander

As usual, we will begin the day by enjoying our delicious breakfast while the train takes us to Bilbao to visit the city and its Guggenheim Museum. Lunch on board and trip to Santander. Tour and dinner. Overnight stay in Santander.

Day 3: Santander – Cabezón de la Sal

Trip to Unquera to visit the gorge of La Hermida and Potes. Lunch; in the afternoon, we will visit Comillas. Dinner and overnight stay in Cabezón de la Sal.

Cabezón de la Sal – Llanes

Visit to Santillana del Mar and the Neo-cave of Altamira; lunch; in the afternoon, we will go further into the Asturias region as far as Llanes. Dinner and overnight stay in Llanes.

Day 5: Llanes – Oviedo

After breakfast, coach trip to the heart of Asturias, Los Picos de Europa National Park, Lakes and Sanctuary of Covadonga, and Cangas de Onís. In the afternoon, Oviedo, tour, dinner, and overnight stay in Oviedo.



Day 6: Oviedo – Luarca

Tour of Gijón and lunch; in the afternoon, visit to Luarca, known as the White Town of the Green Coast. Dinner and overnight stay in Luarca.

Day 7: Luarca – Viveiro

Trip to Ribadeo, while having breakfast, to explore the Lugo coast as far as the Beach of Las Catedrales. Tour of Ribadeo. In the afternoon, train trip to Viveiro, tour, dinner, and overnight stay in Viveiro.

Day 8: Viveiro – Santiago de Compostela

While enjoying our last breakfast on board, we will travel to Ferrol, where El Transcantábrico's coach will be waiting to take us to Santiago de Compostela. The trip will end in the Parador de los Reyes Católicos at around 1 pm.





FROM SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA TO SAN SEBASTIÁN

8 days – 7 nights

Day 1: Santiago de Compostela – Viveiro

Reception at 12 noon in Santiago de Compostela's National Parador. Tour and lunch. In the afternoon, our coach will take us to Ferrol, where the train and its crew will be waiting for us. Welcome and settling in, followed by trip to Viveiro. Dinner and overnight stay in Viveiro.

Day 2: Viveiro – Oviedo

We will begin every day by enjoying our delicious à la carte and buffet breakfast. El Transcantábrico will take us to Ribadeo, tour and stroll along the Beach of Las Catedrales. In the afternoon, tour of Luarca. Dinner on board and overnight stay in Oviedo.

Day 3: Oviedo – Llanes

Tour of Gijón, lunch. In the afternoon, tour of Oviedo. Dinner on board as we travel to Llanes, where we will spend the night.

Day 4: Llanes

We will go up the heart of the Principality of Asturias in our coach. Picos de Europa National Park, Lake Enol, Covadonga Sanctuary, and Cangas de Onís. In the afternoon, Llanes. Dinner on board and overnight stay in Llanes.

Day 5: Llanes - Cabezón de la Sal

During breakfast, the train will travel to Unquero. We will then go by coach to Potes, travelling through the gorge of La Hermida. Tour and lunch. In the afternoon, tour of Comillas, dinner on board and overnight stay in Cabezón de la Sal.

Day 6: Cabezón de La Sal – Santander

After breakfast, we will set off in our coach to visit the Neo-cave of Altamira and Santillana del Mar. In the afternoon, Santander; tour, dinner, and overnight stay in Santander.

Day 7: Santander – Carranza

During breakfast, the train will travel to Bilbao; tour of the city and Guggenheim Museum. Dinner on board and overnight stay in Carranza.

Day 8: Carranza – San Sebastián

Our coach will take us from Bilbao to San Sebastián. Tour and end of trip in San Sebastian's Hotel Barceló–Costa Vasca at around 1 pm.



Short Routes

FROM OVIEDO TO SAN SEBASTIÁN

Day 1: Oviedo – Llanes

Reception at 10 am on board the train in Oviedo Train Station. Tour of Oviedo and lunch; in the afternoon, tour of Gijón. Dinner on board as the train travels to Llanes.

Day 2: Llanes – Cabezón de la Sal

After breakfast, we will go by coach up to the Picos de Europa mountains, Covadonga Lakes and Sanctuary, and Cangas de Onís. Lunch. In the afternoon, tour of Llanes and dinner on board as the train travels to Cabezón de la Sal.

Day 3: Cabezón de la Sal – Santander

On this day, we will visit the Neo-cave of Altamira, and then Santillana del Mar for lunch. In the afternoon, the train will take us to Santander; tour, dinner, and overnight stay in Santander.

Day 4: Santander – San Sebastián

During breakfast, we will travel to Bilbao, where we will say goodbye to the train and its crew. Tour of Bilbao and the Guggenheim Museum, then our coach will take us to San Sebastián; lunch and end of trip in the Hotel Costa Vasca at around 4.30 pm.



FROM SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA TO GIJÓN

Day 1: Santiago de Compostela – Viveiro

Reception at 10 am in Santiago's Parador de los Reyes Católicos, tour, and lunch. In the afternoon, our coach will take us to Ferrol, where the train and its crew will be waiting for us to travel to Viveiro. Tour, dinner, and overnight stay in Viveiro.

Day 2: Viveiro – Ribadeo

During breakfast, the train will travel to Ribadeo, where we will set off to visit Taramundi; lunch followed by return journey to Ribadeo, dinner, and overnight stay.

Day 3: Ribadeo – Luarca

On this day, we will visit Ribadeo and its surroundings, lunch. In the afternoon, we will travel by train to Luarca; tour, dinner, and overnight stay in Luarca.

Day 4: Luarca – Gijón

During breakfast, we will travel to Oviedo, where we will say goodbye to the train and its crew. Tour of Oviedo and coach trip to Gijón. Lunch and end of trip in Gijón's Parador around 4.30 pm.

COSTA VERDE EXPRESS

After the success enjoyed by El Transcantábrico in its first years, in 2000 a twin train was built and refurbished as El Transcantábrico II. In 2011, El Transcantábrico I, which started operating in 1983 and was refurbished in the year 2000, was completely overhauled to give rise to El Transcantábrico Gran Lujo, while El Transcantábrico II's name was changed to El Transcantábrico Clásico. This was the case until 2022, when it was rebranded as the Costa Verde Express, with a shorter route and new livery. A modern luxury train that will enable you to discover the beautiful Green Spain.

Accommodation

The Costa Verde Express' 24 Suites are fully equipped so that you can enjoy the most comfortable stay on board. The Grand-Class Suite is a cosy room with walls panelled in the finest wood, creating a warm, welcoming atmosphere. It features adjustable air-conditioning and a double bed, as well as other comforts to make your stay even more pleasurable: writing desk, wardrobe, luggage closet, minibar, and safe. Each suite has its own complete bathroom, equipped with a shower, hairdryer, and a varied set of welcome items and toiletries. A large window enables you to enjoy the scenery. The entire train is interconnected, which means you can walk throughout its length.



The Common Lounges

The four lounge cars make up the train's most singular and beautiful space. These veritable railway gems amaze passengers due to their external design, finish, and interior decoration. One of the four lounges features a bar and dance floor, with decorations and lighting like a small night club, where you can enjoy entertainment each evening. Another lounge has a second bar for enjoying a relaxing drink. In the other two lounges, you can read, share a board game, chat, or contemplate the scenery through the large windows. Passengers are provided with daily newspapers, magazines, a nice selection of books from the library, television, video library; in short, everything they need to make their trip a real pleasure, as well as a select, professional CREW to look after them. In both the train's elegant lounges and the itinerary's restaurants, innovative CUISINE and the best wines from the north of Spain make this a culinary as well as a cultural trip



Itinerary

FROM BILBAO TO SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

6 days – 5 nights

Day 1: Bilbao – Santander

Reception at Bilbao–Concordia Station at 10 am on board the train. Unpacking. Tour of the city and Guggenheim Museum. Lunch on board while the train sets off for Santander. Tour, dinner, and overnight stay in Santander.

Day 2: Santander – Llanes

While having breakfast, we will travel by train to Cabezón de la Sal; tour of Santillana del Mar and the Neo-cave of Altamira. Lunch. In the afternoon, we will travel by train to Llanes; tour. Dinner on board and overnight stay in Llanes.

Day 3: Llanes – Oviedo

After breakfast, we will travel by coach to Cangas de Onís, Covadonga Sanctuary and Lake Enol in the Picos de Europa mountains. We will then return to the train to travel to Oviedo while having lunch. Tour of Oviedo. Dinner and overnight stay in Oviedo.

Day 4: Oviedo – Luarca

After breakfast, we will visit Gijón; lunch. In the afternoon, we will travel by train to Luarca; tour, dinner on board, and overnight stay in Luarca.

Day 5: Luarca – Viveiro

While having breakfast, we will travel to Ribadeo; tour and lunch in Ribadeo. In the afternoon, Viveiro. Tour, dinner, and overnight stay in Viveiro.

While having breakfast on board the train, we will travel to Ribadeo; tour and lunch. In the afternoon, we will travel by train to the first Asturian locality, Luarca; tour and dinner on board while travelling to Oviedo.

Day 3: Oviedo-Llanes

After breakfast, tour of Gijón and lunch. In the afternoon, tour of Oviedo. We will then travel by train to Llanes. Dinner on board, and overnight stay in Llanes.

Day 4: Llanes – Cabezón de la Sal

After breakfast, coach trip to the Covadonga Sanctuary, Lake Enol and Cangas de Onís. Lunch. In the afternoon, tour of the town of Llanes, thereafter travelling to Cabezón de la Sal while having dinner. Overnight stay in Cabezón de la Sal.

Day 5: Cabezón de La Sal – Santander

After breakfast, we will visit Santillana del Mar and the Neo-cave of Altamira. After lunch, we will travel by train to Santander. Tour, dinner, and overnight stay in Santander.

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EL EXPRESO DE LA ROBLA

El Expreso de la Robla was built in 2009 as a school train to teach port intermodality courses. At the same time, it was used for tourist trips between courses, thereby consolidating a large domestic market. When the courses ended, it continued operating tourist trips all over North Spain's narrow-gauge network. El Expreso de la Robla is a train with a young look, featuring the comfort of legendary European trains as well as the mod cons and technological advances of the 21st century. A cheerful and modern train that will enable you to discover the spectacular scenery of Castile and León.

Accommodation

All El Expreso de La Robla's compartments are equipped with bunkbeds, two per compartment, luggage closet, reading light, air-conditioning, piped music, loudspeakers, telephone, etc., with a modern, young-looking atmosphere that will enable you to rest comfortably. Each compartment has its own bathroom, with a hydromassage shower, washbasin, toilet, and hairdryer. The electricity supply operates at 220 V. The entire train is interconnected, which means you can walk throughout its length. The train has four sleeping cars, with seven compartments per car.



The Common Lounges

El Expreso de La Robla's common spaces are made up of three comfortable lounge cars with a 24-hour bar service. They are equipped with large windows so that you can enjoy the scenery passing slowly by as the train moves along. Passengers are provided with daily newspapers, magazines, a selection of books and videos, and television. The lounges feature air-conditioning, loudspeakers and piped music, as well as a PC with free Internet access for the use of clients.



Itineraries

FROM BILBAO TO LEÓN

3 days – 2 nights



Day 1: Bilbao – Espinosa de Los Monteros

Luggage drop-off at 2 pm in Bilbao's La Concordia Train Station. At 3 pm reception and settling in while the train sets off for Espinosa de Los Monteros. Coach trip to tour the town of Frías and the Tobera waterfalls. Dinner and overnight stay in Espinosa de los Monteros.

Day 2: Espinosa de Los Monteros – Cistierna

After our first breakfast on board, we will explore the Romanesque Art of Palencia, along the Camino de Santiago route; Carrión de los Condes, Frómista, and the Canal de Castilla. In the afternoon, after lunch, tour of the Roman town of La Olmeda. Dinner and overnight stay in Cistierna.

Day 3: Cistierna – León

While having breakfast, we will travel to San Feliz. From there, coach trip to visit the city of León: Old Town, Cathedral and San Isidoro. Lunch and end of trip in the Hotel Real Colegiata de San Isidoro at around 2 pm.

Then the Romanesque Art of Palencia, which is dotted along the Camino de Santiago route; Saldaña, Carrión de los Condes, Frómista, and the Canal de Castilla. Lunch. We will then travel by train to Espinosa de los Monteros, tour, dinner, and overnight stay.

Day 3: Espinosa de los Monteros – Bilbao

While having breakfast, we will travel to Bilbao. Tour of the city and Guggenheim Museum. End of trip at around 2 pm in Bilbao's Train Station.

TREN AL ÁNDALUS

The Al Ándalus Train started operating in 1985 as a way of touring and exploring Andalusia. Due to several setbacks, the train stopped operating in 2005 and was parked in Seville. In 2011, the train was meticulously restored and redecorated, and started travelling again in 2012, this time on Iberian-gauge tracks. This made it more spacious inside, which, along with its length of almost 500 metres, makes it a real palace on wheels. A trip back to the Belle Époque of exquisiteness and sophistication, with the technology of today.

Accommodation

The Al Ándalus Train features two types of accommodation:

The Deluxe Suite: A spacious, elegant suite made up of a bedroom and private bathroom, perfectly adapted for resting and privacy. It features a spacious double bed (200x150cm), which becomes a comfortable sofa during the day. The spacious, comfortable bathroom has a shower, hairdryer, and a varied set of welcome items and toiletries. Safe, minibar, wardrobe, luggage closet or adjustable air-conditioning are other 21st-century comforts that this suite combines with the historic train's original appearance. There are 20 Deluxe Suites.

The Grand-Class Room: A cosy room with a private bathroom, which reflects the same size and atmosphere of the original compartments. It features two single beds that become comfortable armchairs during the day, as well as a minibar, safe, wardrobe, luggage closet, and adjustable air-conditioning. Its functional private bathroom makes good use of space, featuring a shower, hairdryer, and a varied set of welcome items and toiletries. There are 12 Grand-Class Rooms.



The Common Lounges

The Al Ándalus Train houses four railway gems: its four lounge cars from 1928 and 1930. These common areas are designed for leisure and the joy of travelling in the most ample and spacious luxury train, while enjoying the buffet breakfast, lunch, or dinner on board, enjoying a relaxing drink, listening to musical performances, contemplating the scenery, or simply relaxing in their comfortable armchairs. All the cars are air-conditioned and open 24 hours a day for your use and enjoyment. The entire train is interconnected, which means you can walk throughout its length. Restaurant cars, bar, tea lounge –you can enjoy all of them, as well as the service provided by the CREW under the Expedition Manager, accompanied by the guide, head waiter, waiters, musicians and entertainers, cleaning and security staff, train driver, coach driver, and railway and maintenance technicians.

After breakfast, we will visit a winery and enjoy the show "How Andalusian Horses Dance." Lunch on board on our way to Ronda. Dinner in Ronda restaurant and overnight stay in Ronda.

Day 4 Ronda – Cordoba

After breakfast, we will visit Ronda. Lunch on board the train while travelling to Cordoba. Tour, dinner, and overnight stay in Cordoba.

Day 5 Cordoba – Úbeda – Baeza – Granada

After breakfast on board, we will visit the Mosque-Cathedral and continue touring Cordoba. Lunch on board while travelling to visit Úbeda and Baeza, both of which are World Heritage Cities. In the late evening, during dinner, we will arrive in Granada. Overnight stay in Granada.

Day 6: Granada

After breakfast, we will visit Spain's most popular monument, the Alhambra. Lunch. In the afternoon, we will continue touring Granada. Dinner and overnight stay in Granada.

Day 7: Granada – Málaga

After enjoying our last breakfast on board, we will say goodbye to the train and its crew before travelling by coach to Málaga, where we will visit its Alcazaba and enjoy some free time before having lunch. We will end our trip around 5 pm in the station's Sala Club.

Day 6: Jerez – Cadiz – Jerez

After breakfast, our coach will take us to Cadiz. Tour and lunch. In the afternoon, we will return to Jerez. Dinner and overnight stay in Jerez.

Day 7: Seville

During breakfast, we will travel to Seville, where we will say goodbye to the train and its crew. Tour of Seville. Lunch and end of trip in the Hotel Querencia at around 5 pm.
